As part of our continuum of care, our **Transition Program offers a year-round, therapeutic program for high school graduates – or those who have fulfilled their high school requirements – ages 18-22.** Our goal is to empower individuals to build the independent living skills necessary to lead socially-connected and productive lives.

About the program ...

- Our Transition Program establishes a critical pathway for young adults to **EMERGE**, whether it be through academic studies at a community college or vocational interests through part-time jobs or internships.
- These pathways provide young adults the opportunity to **EXPAND** their self-confidence and hone the skill sets necessary to become more independent.
- We maintain a downtown location in Torrington called the HUB, where staff teach critical experiential classes to help young adults **EVOLVE** in areas such as: workplace readiness, interpersonal dynamics, personal health and independent living. The site is located near restaurants, retail shops and, most importantly, paid job opportunities for young adults.

Program features:

- Individual therapy and psychiatry
- Supported vocational placement and higher education opportunities
- Individual transition planning to meet one's goals.
- Supported living environment to strengthen social and executive function skills
